Using Zoom, Art As Mentorship and Making Movies work with Levitt Dayton to present a one-week long intensive that delves into the power of songwriting, the creative process, and the skills it takes to be an artist in the real world. Students will be invited to join the ZOOM room and interact from their homes or classrooms.

Each lesson is 2 hours long - Inspiring and interactive lessons that explore the power of popular song, plus interactions with special guests from Los Lobos, Making Movies, Gina Chavez, & Las Cafeteras, during a 30-minute "Lunch and Learn" workshop live-streamed on Facebook each day so that Levitt audiences can join in on the educational fun!
